IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Bridgetown Board has been working for some months now on revising the Bridgetown Bylaws. These Bylaws will be coming to your mailbox sometime in March. They will be accompanied by a Cover letter with an explanation of the process going forward. These Bylaws will be a topic of discussion, with Bridgetown's Attorney present, at our Annual Meeting scheduled for May 20, 2019. Please put this date on your Calendar, as this will be a very important meeting for you to attend.

For the safety of our Walkers and Dog Walkers, please if you are parking in your driveway, pull all the way up to the garage door so as not to block the sidewalk. It would be appreciated.

As Winter months are here, the Board would ask everyone to prepare your deck for the **snow season. Please remove all debris, pots and miscellaneous items that may blow way or cause unsightliness or damage to the deck over the cold months. Also please clear your driveway of flower pots for easier snow removal. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.**

If you have a dog and walk around the Community, **please, please, remember to pick up after your dog.** It has been brought to our attention that there are many “land mines” in our common grasses. If you see someone from another Community walking please advise them we pick up in Bridgetown.

Also please be aware of a couple of dogs on Arthur Street which have been identified as “aggressive” toward other dogs. Perhaps small dog owners should beware of your walks on Arthur Street.

New and Seasonal Tips

If you are considering a Satellite Dish Installation for your TV/Internet please be sure to go to the website BridgetownCondominiums.com and read the Antennae Policy and fill also it requires a Modification Request Form which can also be found on the website.

If you are in need of a Ramp off of your deck, please remember that requires a Modification Request and the form may be found on our Website. Modification requests require Board approval.

The rust stains you are seeing in the driveways and on sidewalks in some areas are NOT from our water!! It is a result of the snow plow blades that were used this winter.

Trash day pick up is early on Tuesday Morning. Please be aware that we have Critters who love your trash, so please don't feed them until the night before pickup day.

Also Recycle day pick up is early on Wednesday Morning. **We would ask that you keep your Recycle Bin in your Garage except for the night before pickup or day of pickup.**

Holiday's that fall on Monday DOES NOT delay our Trash pickup days. ONLY Holiday's that fall on Tuesday's and Wednesday's, then both Recycle and Trash may be picked up on same day.

Please remember, dogs are not to be left unattended outside of our Units, and please pick up after them as you are walking around our Community.

Please keep all personal items off the grass area for the lawn cutting crew.

Modification Requests forms are available on our Website. **These requests are for any modifications you would like to make on the outside of your unit.** For example: windows, enhancements to landscaping, radon mitigation systems, new outside A/C units, handicapped railings or ramps to name a few.
