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2021 ANNUAL MEETING RESULTS

The Annual Meeting was held, May 25th at the Back Gate area due to COVID restrictions. There was a quorum present. 2020 accomplishments were discussed as well as 2021 projects.

Election of the Board of Directors occurred by Ballot. The Board Members listed above will remain. Questions and comments were received and noted from Co-Owners.

SPRING PROJECTS

The following are Spring Projects that have been approved by the Board:

1. "Evergreen Outdoor" is a new Contractor to service and update/upgrade and repair, as needed, our Irrigation/Sprinkler system. **System to Open, Wednesday, June 2nd.**
2. Buildings #102 and #103 which include addresses 819-829 and 831-841; will have New Roofs this Summer. Details to individuals will follow with start dates. **Roofs completed.**
3. Buildings #107, 202 and 206 which include addresses 800-810, 905-917 and 945-953 will have the Decks repaired/painted this Summer. Details to individuals will follow with start dates. **Decks completed.**
4. Fraleighs Landscape Nursery will be providing New Landscape Improvements which will include the new Entrance Garden, improved East and West gardens and removing 2 front yard gardens to be replaced with grass seed. Work will commence Monday, April 5th, weather permitting. **Project completed.**
5. Driveway/sidewalk repair/replacement, **Quote has been approved, expected start date Middle of June.**
6. Tree removal update- dead/disease trees have been removed. Arborviteas at the transformer locations have been removed and new plantings are done. Seeding of these areas will be done in late August.

Updated Bylaws should be left in the Unit for the new Owners.

Just a heads up on the placement of your Orange Trash bags and your Recycle cart, it must be placed on the extension, between the road and sidewalk. If it is not the City will NOT pick it up.

FYI – New screen doors to any Unit should be purchased in the color: Black
New front doors and trim should be painted: Valspar Duramax Exterior base 2 latex satin – 8915-1Y45; 8930-1Y34; 8935-1Y27.5

For the safety of our Walkers and Dog Walkers, please if you are parking in your driveway, pull all the way up to the garage door so as not to block the sidewalk. It would be appreciated.

FYI, everyone might want to check out the City of Chelsea website (City-Chelsea.org) where you can find useful information.

The Board has asked Realtors to use a “For Sale” sign that looks like a “Yard Sign” instead of the Realtor signs that use a 4x4 post. Once the 4x4 is removed Bridgetown is left with a hole to fill in. So if you are considering selling, please ask your Realtor to use the “Yard “For Sale” Sign”. Cooperation would be appreciated.

If you are considering a Satellite Dish Installation for your TV/Internet please be sure to go to the website BridgetownCondominiums.com and read the Antennae Policy and fill also it requires a Modification Request Form which can also be found on the website.

Trash day pick up is early on Tuesday Morning. Please be aware that we have Critters who love your trash, so please don't feed them until the night before pickup day.

Also Recycle day pick up is early on Wednesday Morning. **We would ask that you keep your Recycle Bin in your Garage except for the night before pickup or day of pickup.**

Holiday's that fall on Monday DOES NOT delay our Trash pickup days. ONLY Holiday's that fall on Tuesday's and Wednesday's, then both Recycle and Trash may be picked up on same day.

BLUE RIBBON STRAWBERRY PIE

1 Quart fresh Strawberries
1 cup sugar
¼ cup cornstarch
1 cup water

Have your pie shell baked and cooled.

Chop one cup of Strawberries. Combine sugar and cornstarch in saucepan. Stir in water gradually until smooth. Add chopped (one cup) Strawberries. Cook, stirring constantly until mixture thickens and boils. Remove from heat. Add food coloring if desired. Cool in refrigerator for ½ hour. Pour ¾ of the mixture into prepared pie crust. Stand up remaining Strawberries in pie crust and pour remaining mixture over Strawberries. Garnish with 3 large Strawberries. Chill until firm, 3 hours. Top with Cool Whip or Whipped Cream.

This is quick, easy, a “never fail”, and really good recipe!! I double it for larger pie.
