THIS SUMMER'S PROJECTS

The landscaping project of burying the black pipes, removing old bushes and laying sod has been completed on all sides.

The removal of 5 dead trees – will be a 2020 project

Install weather stripping on garage doors as needed – this project is in progress and at this time, all single garage doors that were tagged for this project have been completed. The double garage doors will be done next.

The Railing Sand and Painting project will be a 2020 project.

FYI – New screen doors to any Unit should be purchased in the color: Black
New front doors and trim should be painted: Valspar Duramax Exterior base 2 latex satin – 8915-1Y45; 8930-1Y34; 8935-1Y27.5
Deck color: Olympic Elite – Olivewood (at Home Depot)

If you are going to be out of town for any length of time, please turn off your water at the main shut off. It may save you from returning to a mess of broken water pipes. If you need help locating the main shut off, please let one of the Board Members know.

For the safety of our Walkers and Dog Walkers, please if you are parking in your driveway, pull all the way up to the garage door so as not to block the sidewalk. It would be appreciated.

FYI, everyone might want to check out the City of Chelsea website (City-Chelsea.org) where you can find useful information. For example: “Energy Smart Program” you can receive up to a \$4 rebate for each LED bulb, recycle your refrigerator and receive \$50 rebate check, just to name a few. More good information can be found on this website.

The Board has asked Realtors to use a “For Sale” sign that looks like a “Yard Sign” instead of the Realtor signs that use a 4x4 post. Once the 4x4 is removed Bridgetown is left with a hole to fill in. So if you are considering selling, please ask your Realtor to use the “Yard “For Sale” Sign”. Cooperation would be appreciated.

New and Seasonal Tips

If you are considering a Satellite Dish Installation for your TV/Internet please be sure to go to the website BridgetownCondominiums.com and read the Antennae Policy and fill also it requires a Modification Request Form which can also be found on the website.

If you are in need of a Ramp off of your deck, please remember that requires a Modification Request and the form may be found on our Website. Modification requests require Board approval.

Trash day pick up is early on Tuesday Morning. Please be aware that we have Critters who love your trash, so please don't feed them until the night before pickup day.

Also Recycle day pick up is early on Wednesday Morning. **We would ask that you keep your Recycle Bin in your Garage except for the night before pickup or day of pickup.**

Holiday's that fall on Monday DOES NOT delay our Trash pickup days. ONLY Holiday's that fall on Tuesday's and Wednesday's, then both Recycle and Trash may be picked up on same day.

Please remember, dogs are not to be left unattended outside of our Units, and please pick up after them as you are walking around our Community.

Please keep all personal items off the grass area for the lawn cutting crew.

LEMON CRANBERRY ZUCCHINI BREAD OR MUFFINS

2 cups flour
3 eggs
½ cup oil
1 cup zucchini, shredded
1 cup dried cranberries, divided
¾ cup sugar
½ cup milk
¼ cup lemon juice
1-1/2 teaspoon baking powder
½ teaspoon baking soda
½ teaspoon salt
Zest of one lemon

Mix oil, eggs, sugar – add milk, lemon juice and lemon zest stirring until thoroughly mixed.

Mix flour, baking powder, baking soda and salt until well combined. Fold in shredded zucchini and ¾ cup of the cranberries.

Pour batter into prepared loaf pan and top with remaining cranberries. Bake at 350 degrees until toothpick inserted into the center comes out clean. 50-60 minutes. Cool in pan 5-10 minutes before inverting to cool.

Slice, serve and Enjoy!!!
